UNLEASHING THE POWER WITHIN

Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in the present truth. Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting you in remembrance. [2Peter 1:12-13]

Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands. For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. [2Timothy 1:6-7]

The Apostles Peter and Paul wanted the readers of these epistles to remember something. Both of these epistles were written in about 66AD which was only about 33 years after the church was born on the day of Pentecost.

Biblical historians tell us the Epistle of Jude was also written during this same time period or perhaps a few years later. In Jude's epistle he warns the church, "*Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called: Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied. Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ. I will therefore*

put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.” [Jude 1:1-5]

Jude also wanted readers of his epistle to remember something! I submit to you that something had been lost or forgotten during the period of years between Pentecost and when these epistles were written. I also believe it was more than any doctrinal issue. What was it? I do believe it was something concerning knowledge, because it was something to remember. But knowledge of what?

Some years back I was praying for God to send a Holy Ghost Revival. Many times I have cried out to God, “Lord, send a revival”! I’m sure many of you have prayed this same prayer. It was during one of these times I heard that still small Voice of the Spirit say to me, “Quit praying for revival”. It stunned me! Quit praying for something I believed we desperately needed?

Then, the Lord began to speak to my spirit by revelation. The Spirit began to say these words to me, “Quit praying for revival for I have sent you to bring revival.”

I began to question the Spirit concerning what I believed I had heard. “Lord, you want me to bring a revival? How can I do such a thing?” “I need reviving myself!”

With the help of the Holy Spirit I want to share with you what He gave me that day.

There can be no true revelation from the Spirit that the Word of God will not agree with. If you believe God has spoken something to you and you cannot find witness of it in the Written Word then you can rest assured that it was not God that spoke it. The Spirit and the Word will agree.

I believed it was the Spirit of God that was speaking to me. He was telling me to, “Bring Revival”. As a matter of fact that Voice also said to me, “You are revival”!

Well friends, I certainly didn’t feel like I was a revival or even in a revival. When all this came to me, I needed a

revival! So, I went to the Word and asked the Lord to show all this to me.

Here is what He revealed. After giving me our opening scriptures concerning remembering something, He brought me to Matthew chapter three and verse eleven, *"I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire"*.

I began to see that the Spirit wanted me to remember what happened in the beginning of the preaching of Jesus and the Apostles. John the Baptist testified that Jesus came to baptize us with *"the Holy Ghost and with fire"*.

The scriptures began to open up to me about the baptism of the Holy Ghost and what it meant. I believed in and have experienced the Pentecostal experience of speaking in tongues. Millions throughout the world today testify of this experience. But I found the baptism of the Holy Ghost was more, *much more* than just speaking in tongues!

Jesus said, *"In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)"* [John 7:37-39]

Jesus was so very plain that when the Holy Ghost came into a person that person would become a vessel of life! For out of their belly would flow rivers of living water! Not just a river, but rivers! Praise God! Rivers of Living Water! Ask any farmer where the life of his plants come from. He will tell you, "rain". Scientists will tell you, "where there is water, there is life".

A revival is a resurrection, a restoring! Revival means to revive, to bring back to life. This is what the Spirit was

speaking to me! Inside of you is life. Inside of you are rivers of living water! I believe God was telling me to unleash or release this power that was within me. Praise God!

Christians have prayed and prayed for something that we are supposed to have already! Revival! Life! It is in us! There's something on the inside! I believe wherever a truly Spirit filled man or woman goes in this old world they can bring revival. This is why the Spirit was telling me, "You Are Revival"! He was awakening me, and now I want to awaken you with the help of God's Holy Spirit.

The world does need a revival. However, in most cases the church needs an awakening to what God has already given them that they may go forth and bring in the harvest. I believe there is a great harvest to be reaped in the end time. But the vine of the earth is withered, it is dried up. It needs rain. Holy Ghost Rain!

If you have the Holy Ghost you have got something in you that is far greater than any problem or demoniac power you will ever face.

"Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world" [1John 4:4].

Greater is He that is in you! The overcoming power of the Living God dwells in His people. The Bible tells us, "For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones." [Ephesians 5:30] We are His body in the earth. Flesh of His flesh, bone of His Bone! The Word of God goes on to tell us, "But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit" [1Corinthians 6:17]. One spirit with the Lord! I believe the baptism of the Holy Spirit blends our spirit with the Spirit of our Lord. Thus, we become His body; one spirit with Him.

Jesus was one with the Father and He prayed that we would also be one. "Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I

in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me" [John 17:20-23]. One Lord, One Faith, One Baptism, One Church! True oneness, is God in Christ, and Christ in you. If you are "born again" you have become one with God through Christ. Glory to God! As Jesus manifested the Father, we should be manifesting Christ!

I hope you are beginning to see why the Spirit said, "*You are revival!*"! Think about it! You are baptized in the Holy Ghost; you have the Eternal Spirit of the Living Creator God dwelling in you. Not only that, you are presently the flesh and bones of the body of Christ. Just as Christ was the expressed image of God's Person, you are now the expressed image of the Living Christ. **YOU ARE REVIVAL!** Eternal Life is in you and **GOD WANTS YOU** to unleash the Power that is already within you.

Let me be bold for a moment with this comment from the Apostle Paul. Look at this: "*Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father"* [Philippians 2:5-11].

Let this mind (allow this thought) be in you! Christ found Himself in the Very Form (Image) of God. Therefore, he did not think (consider) it robbery to be equal (on a par

with) with God. Paul said, "I want you to think the same way Christ did"!

What form are you in? Are we not the body of Christ? *"That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all"* [Ephesians 1:17-23].

God wants us to open the eyes of our hearts! He desires to give us an understanding of what, and who we are! Christ is the Head of His body, we are His body and His feet; and God has placed ALL THINGS under His feet. Think of this: the body of Christ (which we are) extends from the earth to the Throne of God in Heaven itself! And everything; principalities, powers, kingdoms are all under the feet of His body. Look at that! The lowest member of the Body has authority over all things!

Oh, I hope you get this! We are the temples of the Living God! Sometimes we think of God as being someone or something that exists far away in the heavens way beyond the Milky Way. When in fact, we are the habitation of God. *"In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit"* [Ephesians 2:22]. Paul said in his epistles to the Corinthians: *"Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?"* [1Corinthians 3:16]. *"And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living*

God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people” [2Corinthians 6:16].

Isn't it about time to believe the Word of the Living God and put Satan under our feet where he belongs. The devil has tormented you too long, now it's your turn to torment the devil! Praise the Lord!

I firmly believe if we could receive what the Spirit and the Word is revealing in this message, we could turn the world upside down. The early church did it! Yes they did! How? They didn't have all the technology, gadgets, airplanes, concordances, and promotional skills of today. How did they *"turn the world upside down"* in their day? I believe you now know the answer. It was not by power, nor by might, but by the Spirit of the Living God that was in them! *"And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God" [1Corinthians 2:4-5].*

The Apostle Paul was a wise master builder. Much wiser than most today! You see, he built the church of his day by the Spirit of the Living God. Today, men try to build churches with the latest marketing tools available to them. It is a sad thing to say, but no longer do men seek out the anointed ones, but rather, they seek out the secular educated ones. This is why there is little moving of God's Spirit in the modern church world. We have forsaken the "Fountain of Living Waters" for the carnal wisdom of men.

You may be able to build a church building, and entice many to come with all the carnal gimmicks you can muster, but you will wind up with nothing more than a club house full of the unsaved if your ministry is not anointed of the Holy Ghost.

I feel like rising up from my desk and shouting, "I AM REVIVAL! I HAVE THE ANOINTING OF GOD IN MY LIFE

THAT WILL DESTROY THE YOKE OF THE DEVIL!" What about you?

The Apostle Paul asked Timothy to do something in our opening scripture, "*Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.*" Now, I ask each reader the same. I ask you to remember what God has given you, and I ask you to stir up the gift of God that is already IN YOU! That Gift, I believe, is the Gift of the Holy Ghost! The Gift is the answer to revival! Church planting can be done by all kinds of carnal ways. But God's Church can only be planted by the Holy Ghost.

I do not believe there is anything impossible to a man or woman that will believe God. There is no power that can stand against the anointed ones of God. "*Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.*" [Romans 8:37] Truly, we are MORE than conquerors!

There are so many other scriptures I could use to *prove* what the Spirit spoke to me that day. However, I will close with one that has been a favorite over the years. It reminds me that there is something on the inside of my being that is greater than anything I could possibly imagine. To sum it all up, let me say along with the Apostle Paul, "there is a Power in us that is able to do far above anything we could ask for or think". That Power was given to share with the peoples of the world. Freely we have received, freely we must give. That Power is the Holy Spirit; the Fountain of Living Waters which is IN YOU.

"Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us." [Ephesians 3:20]
