THE MINISTRY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

We find the Holy Spirit has many ministries! He is our Comforter, Teacher, Guide and Revealer of God's truths. He is also a Reprover, Baptizer, Giver of Gifts, Helper and Intercessor. An important ministry of the Holy Spirit is that He actually prays for us about things we are not aware of! Every Christian needs the Holy Spirit in their lives!

COMFORTER:

"So I returned, and considered all the oppressions that are done under the sun: and behold the tears of such as were oppressed, and they had no comforter; and on the side of their oppressors there was power; but they had no comforter. Wherefore I praised the dead which are already dead more than the living which are yet alive" [Ecclesiastes 4:1-2]. The writer of Ecclesiastes writes of such torment that he praised the dead more than the living. In other words it would be far better to die than live!

Oh yes, there will be times in your life when you will need someone to comfort you. There is no better One to comfort you than the Comforter our Lord has given us. He will be there during our times of sorrow and despair. He can bring you out of the shadows of hopelessness and bring the Light of our Lord to smile upon you and give you an

everlasting Comfort and hope. Jesus called the Holy Spirit the Comforter! "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever" [John 14:16].

Many times I have prayed with grieving loved ones before a funeral and witnessed the comforting Power of the Holy Spirit.

TEACHER, GUIDE AND REVEALER:

The Holy Spirit is also our Teacher, Guide and Revealer. I believe He accomplishes this in various ways. First, He opens up the Scriptures to us by supernatural revelation. Secondly, He anoints men and women to teach us. Thirdly, He guides us into all truth. Notice, the Greek word for quide is "to show the way". The Holy Spirit guides, He doesn't push, He is gentle, He shows you the way to go. Lastly, the Holy Spirit will show you things to come. He will reveal to you future events! "But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you" [John 14:26]. "Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will quide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come" John 16:13].

Please notice in John 16:13 Jesus said the Holy Spirit will not speak of Himself! "He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you" [John 16:14]. He will glorify Jesus! The word glorify means to esteem, full of (have) glory, honour, magnify. Just as Jesus Trumpet Messenger Page 10

glorified and magnified the Father, the Holy Spirit will only magnify Jesus. Jesus said, "Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works" [John 14:10]. In the same way the Holy Spirit will not speak of Himself but will magnify Jesus as Jesus did His Father. As the example given to us by our Lord Jesus, we should always magnify the God that lives in us. For it is He doeth the works!

REPROVER:

The Holy Spirit Reproves. "And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged" [John 16:8-11]. He corrects errors in the world and in your life! The word reprove means to convict, convince, tell a fault, rebuke, reprove. I believe the Holy Spirit will bring your attention to any area of your life that's not pleasing to God. I thank God for this! I realize that I might unconsciously do something that doesn't please the Father. I thank God for this ministry of the Holy Spirit that awakens me and stirs me to repentance. We desperately need the convicting power of the Holy Spirit in our lives!

BAPTIZER:

We must be baptized in the Holy Spirit. We discover in the following scriptures that the Holy Spirit is also a baptizer! "For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one Trumpet Messenger Page 11

body: so also is Christ. For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit" [1Corinthians 12:12-13].

Never forget, the body is many, but there is only One Spirit!

GIVER OF GIFTS:

The Holy Spirit is the Giver of the gifts of the Spirit! When reading through the nine gifts of the Spirit I realized this is a very important ministry of the Holy Spirit. Beginning with verse four of First Corinthians chapter twelve look carefully at these verses and you will find that Paul is talking about the same Spirit.

"Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he [1Corinthians 12:4-11]. Paul is talking about the Holy Spirit and how the Holy Spirit will be manifested: Through the Gifts of the Holy Spirit! We see there are nine gifts of the Trumpet Messenger Page 12

Spirit! That is nine different ways in this single passage how the Holy Spirit ministers. Space in this article will not allow for us to investigate these nine different ministry gifts. Paul went on to say in the fourteenth chapter that we should desire spiritual gifts. I believe the Holy Spirit wants to give us spiritual gifts in order for Christ to be manifested!

Never forget that the gifts the Holy Spirit imparts in your life are for others, although they will certainly impact and bless you as well! "But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal" [1Corinthians 12:7].

HELPER AND INTERCESSOR:

The Holy Spirit is our helper and intercessor. The Holy Spirit lives in our inner man. He knows all about us and according to Ephesians chapter three, verse sixteen *he strengthens our inner man!*

Because the Holy Spirit lives in our inner man he gives us the ability to pray in the Spirit. "For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful. What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also" [1Corinthians 14:14-15]. The Holy Spirit enables us to both pray and sing in the Spirit with and without understanding. We can pray in an unknown tongue or with our native language! The unknown tongue you are speaking is to God. This is revealed in this verse, "For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries" [1Corinthians 14:2].

The Holy Spirit's ministry of intercessor has always amazed me. I read a little tract once that asked the question, "Can God talk to God?" The tract was referring to Jesus and the Father. There should be little doubt that Jesus most certainly prayed and talked to the Father!

But with the thought, "Can God Talk to God?" in mind let's look at the very important intercessory ministry of the Holy Spirt. He is our Prayer Warrior within!

In Romans chapter eight Paul writes that the Spirit helps our *infirmities* which is defined as, *feebleness* (of body or mind); by implication *malady*; disease, infirmity, sickness, weakness. "Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God" [Romans 8:26-27].

These two verses give a powerful overview of this great ministry of the Holy Spirit! He helps our infirmities by interceding on our behalf. Paul knows there are times when we just don't know what to pray for. The enemy may be attacking us in an area that we are not yet aware of. However, the Holy Spirit searches hearts and knows the will of God for us. Therefore the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings which cannot be uttered! Isn't it wonderful that you not only have saints and ministers praying for you, but you have the Holy Spirit Himself interceding for you!
